MEMBER OBLIGATIONS

The following list outlines obligations noted in the NHS National Constitution:

Maintaining Standards

Once selected, members are expected to maintain the standards by which they were selected. Members should be well informed about selection standards.

Meetings

Chapters hold meetings and may require members to attend. The schedule of these meetings should be well publicized.

Chapter Service Project(s)

All chapters are required to sponsor a chapter service project and all members are required to participate, assuming that the project meets the criteria as outlined in the National Constitution.

Individual Service Projects(s)

In addition to the chapter service project, members engage in additional service to match their own talents and interests. Chapter bylaws should specify the amount of service and how the chapter monitors this activity.

Dues

Chapters are not required to charge dues, but if established, members can be required to pay in a timely manner. If dues are charged, the constitution limits this amount per student per year. The school should be able to provide alternative funding for students who may be unable to pay. The authentic inability of a member or his/her family to pay dues or other chapter financial obligations should not be a reason for discipline or dismissal of any member.

Additional Obligations

If additional obligations exist, the chapter bylaws should spell these out. It is recommended that bylaws be presented to each member yearly as a reminder of these and all member obligations.
